

Og Pozzoli

Brazilian entrepreneur Og Pozzoli was one of the most renowned car collectors in the world. He owned a collection of around 200 automobiles. Amongst them were two of the oldest Fiat Gardeners, from 1912 and 1914, which he refused to sell for \$1 million to Gianni Agnelli, the former president of FIAT.

In his collection there were cars that served popes, presidents of the Republic from different countries, unique examples in the world, which he began to acquire in 1958. Since his death, the collection is in the process of being transformed into a museum in the city of Campos do Jordão, Brazil.
