CONFERENCE INVITATION:

We invite you to the third European conference for automotive history, to be held at the MAuto, Museo Nazionale dell'Automobile, Corso Unità d'Italia 40, Torino, Italia, from 14 to 16 October 2022.

After the success of the two first Conferences held at the Cité de l'Automobile in Mulhouse, in 2017, and at the Louwman Museum in den Haag, in 2019, MAuto generously offered to act as host for the next conference. We also thank the FIVA Culture and Youth Commission for lending their support.

The programme features presentations (in English) on a wide range of topics from automotive historians. The provisional programme is as follows:

Friday 14 October, arrival, informal dinner in the hotel restaurant (to be arranged—at delegate's own cost).

Saturday 15 October, conference in the Museum from 9.00, with a break for lunch, followed by dinner (lunch and dinner included in conference fee). The evening dinner will be held in the Museum.

Sunday 16 October, a morning session in the Museum, starting at 9.00, ending at lunchtime (option of lunch in museum café at delegate's own cost); we hope to arrange an afternoon visit.

The conference fee, including lunch and dinner on Saturday 15 October, will be €150 per person; for partners attending *only* the Saturday dinner, €75 (which includes museum entrance). If you wish to take part in the conference sessions *without* having dinner Saturday evening, €80.
